#### **Emotional Health and Wellbeing Services Training Offer**

Compass and Chilypep are commissioned by Barnsley CCG and BMBC to deliver training and support packages to education settings in the local area.

The emotional health and wellbeing group led by BMBC CYP Public Health are offering a one-day FREE whole school interactive, face to face, bespoke training package for secondary schools around emotional health and wellbeing. Ideal for inset days and progressing the whole school relational approach to emotional health and wellbeing, this one-day training will provide practical resources to use in school to support children and young people's emotional health and wellbeing. Real-life scenarios with on-hand support from practitioners from a variety of fields (Education Inclusion, CYP Public Health, Early Help, Compass Be, IDAS, BSACRS, 0-19's Public Health Nursing services, Chilypep etc.) will strengthen connections for future support and the training day will also provide links to the Healthier Futures Accreditation (where applicable.)
